

MAINTENANCE TIPS

After installation, your concrete surface can be easily maintained by following the instructions set out below;

OUTDOOR APPLICATION

The best tools for the job are your garden hose, a good stiff broom, and a little elbow grease,. Any dirt or air-borne materials can be removed quickly by using this method. First, sweep the area clean and then hose off and let the surface dry.

FOOD AND LIQUIDS (Beer, Wine or Soft drinks)

All spillages should be removed as soon as possible to prevent staining of the surface, Clean water mixed with mild washing detergent will not harm the concrete surface, Scrub the area with a soft bristled brush or broom, then wash area immediately

GREASE AND OIL STAINS

Grease and oil stains must be treated immediately first wipe off any oil or grease with an absorbent cloth, then apply a mild water based degreasing solution. Apply the solution to the area immediately and work into grease or oil. Rinse the area and re-apply if required, completely clean the entire area using a mild detergent, then rinse with clean water..

Note: If oils, grease or any chemical solution is left on the surface for too long, removal will be very hard and staining may occur,

INDOOR APPLICATION

Using the same cleaning method as for food and liquid spillages is advised mild detergent with water and soft scrub.

YOU MUST NOT

Apply solvent based cleaning products to the surface. Use water based products only.

Apply acid or chemical products to the surface.

Drag heavy furniture / objects across the surface.

Drive on the surface for seven days after application

YOU MUST

Remove spillages as soon as they happen. Sweep and hose down surface on a regular basis. Call your concrete outlet when resealing is required and use Addcrete products only.
